What can I do with my 120 chart?

Read the numbers as fast as you can.

Read the numbers backward as fast as you can.

Pick a number, then count on by 10s.

Read all of the numbers in a column.

Read the numbers in a row.

Pick a number and tell how many tens and ones it has.

Pick a number and tell what is 1 more and 1 less than that number.

Pick a number and tell what is 10 more and 10 less than that number.

Have someone cover a few numbers with pennies or a small object. Then guess what numbers are hidden.

Race to 120 (2 players): Roll 2 dice and add the numbers together. Then, starting at 1, move your penny that many places. Players rotate turns until a player lands exactly on 120.

Read your chart in a silly voice, like a monster, a queen/king, a frog, an opera singer, or another funny voice.
